The wines, made from grapes grown in the Central Ranges are all fresh and lively and are perfect quaffing wines for the silly season.

The semillon sauvignon blanc shows fresh cut granny smith apple aromas integrated with lime and citrus zest. It is quite a viscous wine, with good mouth-filling flavours. Chill it down and enjoy.
