## Angullong Orange Region Shiraz 2006

GREAT news for Angullong - their 2008 sauvignon blanc was awarded two trophies at the Sydney Royal Wine Show. This is a fantastic result, proving the quality of wine being produced in Orange is as good as anywhere in Australia. While the 2008 savvy will sell out quickly, take a moment to have a look at some of the other Angullong wines.

The 2006 Angullong shiraz also offers great value. It is a youthful wine with lifted plum, blackberry and floral aromas. The palate shows nicely integrated oak treatment with subtle and elegant tannins. After sitting in the glass, the wine really opens up with added raspberry, spice and white pepper shining through.

## Dindima Orange Region Semillon 2008

THE 2008 Dindima Semillon is a lovely wine. The fruit from 2008 was so clean and crisp that winemaker James Bell decided not mature the wine in oak. This fruit, having been carefully protected on the vine by new bird netting, was taken to the winery, whole bunch pressed and cold stabilised with new equipment that the Bells had recently invested in.

The result is a wine that is grassy, citrusy and herbaceous, with many similarities to a sauvignon blanc. The palate is full of passionfruit and gooseberry flavours, with a zesty and solid acid backbone structure. If you're a fan of sauvignon blanc, have a taste of this.

## Brothers in Arms Langhorne Creek Cabernet Sauvignon 2005

THE Brothers in Arms winery is located in Langhorne Creek in South Australia. This winegrowing region is not as famous as its cousin, the Coonawarra, however some of Australia's great wines hail from this region. The Stonyfell Metala Cabernet Shiraz is made from Langhorne Creek fruit and the 1962 vintage won the inaugural Jimmy Watson Trophy – arguably Australia's most sought after wine award.

The Brothers in Arms cabernet uses fruit from the Metala vineyard. It is an intense and rich wine with mint, chocolate, blackberry and cherry oak aromas. The palate is silky and fleshy with powdery, yet approachable tannins and great length of flavour.
