## Brangayne Orange Region Sauvignon Blanc 2009

There are some lovely Orange Region sauvignon blancs from the 2009 vintage. This was an excellent vintage and a great follow on from the 2008. Time will tell how the 2010 vintage plays out. Some to look out for include Printhe, Angullong and Patina, as well as the Brangayne. These are all very well priced and offer great value.

The Brangayne, as with these other Savvies, is fresh and inviting with ripe passionfruit, guava and mango flavours with some herbaceousness. There is a slight chalkiness, which adds to the appeal. The acid is tight and zesty making it perfect as an aperitif, which will get the taste buds excited

## Epsilon Barossa Valley Shiraz 2007

Epsilon is a small vigneron in the Barossa who has been making wine since 2003. The family behind Epsilon are fifth-generation grape growers so they should know a thing or two about the region.

The 2007 Shiraz is a lovely, luscious Barossa red. The attractive aromas include white pepper and loads of rich ripe berry fruit. These flow nicely through to the palate with chocolate and caramel flavours adding further decadence. The tannins are in check and the oak has been judged beautifully. This is a big, flavoursome wine, as you would expect from the Barossa, however, it is not over the top and each mouthful leaves you wanting another.
